




World Church Administrators Survey 2013/2014

Introduction

- A survey of administrators employed by the Seventh-day Adventist Church around the world was conducted in the autumn of 2013.
- The sample was made up of Church administrators such as officers, associate officers, departmental directors, and associate departmental directors of unions and divisions.
- ■The total number of respondents n=560.
- A separate survey of administrators was carried out in autumn of 2012 for the evaluation of *Adventist World*, which included officers and departmental directors of conferences. Total number of respondents n=986
- This report draws mainly on the survey of union and division administrators, amplified by the wider survey at certain points, and by the 2013 survey of church pastors

Administrators' Age






Fig. 7 Age Range of Pastors from the Adventist Pastors' Study




Administrators by division share




Administrators' age, division-by-division breakdown





Number of Years Employed by the SDA Church





Isolation of "five years" and "over ten years" employment















Service in Large Urban Areas






Administrators' Area of Specialization
