Technical summary

It was a descriptive exploratory study that provides a portrait of the

Adventist membership in the Inter-American Division, documenting and

evaluating the current state of religious behavior, attitudes and experiences,

well-being, beliefs, and health. In addition, how the church, family, and

congregational climate explain the spiritual experience of the Adventist member

inside and outside the church.

Keywords: faith, beliefs, perceptions, attitudes, spiritual experience.

DESCRIPTION

Objective

• Identify family, congregational and educational factors related to the

maturity of the faith and the loyalty to the denomination.

Know the effectiveness of the programs offered by the local leadership of

the church, including pastoral leadership. Determine the degree of

commitment that the Adventist member has regarding the beliefs of the

church.

- Determine how they perceive the congregational climate.
- Share the results of this research with the organizations of the Inter-American Division.
- Identify the degree of participation in the programs and service structures of the church.
- Inform the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists regarding the faith, beliefs, perceptions, attitudes, and actions of church members in the Inter-American Division.
- Provide information on the experience of Adventist members of the Inter-American Division.

Contribution to the advancement of knowledge.

An objective understanding of the spiritual experience of the Adventist members was obtained and allowed to diagnose the most felt needs. It will provide valuable information to the leaders of the church to guide the planning of the departments while offering appropriate information regarding the programs and seminars that need to be developed in the territory.

Geographical Scope/Target Audience

The Inter-American Division encompasses 43 countries, three greater language groups, and a great variety of cultures and ethnic groups. The IAD has 3,650,038 active church members in 13,216 local churches belonging to 24 Unions (General Conference Corporation of Seventh day Adventists 2016).

The Inter-American Division of the Seventh-day Adventist Church was organized in 1922 and includes the following territories: Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, Aruba, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Curacao, Dominica, Dominican Republic,

El Salvador, French Guiana, Grenada, Guadeloupe, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Martinique, Mexico, Montserrat, Nicaragua, Panama, Puerto Rico, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Sint Maarten, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands, United States Virgin Islands, Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of); the overseas Saint Barthelemy, and Saint Martin French collectivities; and the Netherland's special overseas municipalities of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, and Saba.

Data Collection:

It was carried out by the team of the Department of Postgraduate Management and Research based on the information provided by the survey composed of 289 questions applied in printed and electronic form.

Data Analysis:

The SPSS statistical program will be used to analyze beliefs, perceptions, attitudes, and actions reported by Church members.

Results

Section 1. Personal Demographics




Figure 1. Participants.

The sample was made up of 5,185 participants, members of 23 Unions belonging to the Inter-American Division (figure 1). 55% were women and 45% men; 76% of the participants have indicated that they have not been employed by the Adventist church, 15% are currently employed, while 9% have been employed in the past.




Figure 2. Discapacity

Regarding the disability category, 87% said they did not have a disability, while 13% had some type of disability (Visual, cognitive, movement, deafness, speech, other). Figure 2 shows that the disability that occurs most frequently is visual, while the least frequent are deafness and speech.




Figure 3. Institutions iASD

Of the total number of participants, 25.3% indicated having finished university studies, 8.7% postgraduate studies, 18.1% finished high school, 9.3 finished primary school, 16.9 high school, 20.3% did not complete their studies, while there is a 1.4% that did not attend school. Regarding formal studies carried out in IASD institutions, 20% attended primary or secondary education, 20% high school or baccalaureate, 20% university, 8% postgraduate, while 32% have not studied in IASD institutions (Figure 3).

Section 2. Demographics, home, and religion

Regarding home demographics, there is an average of 4.17 people per household, of which 3.42 keep the Saturday as the Sabbath. That is, of every 4 people in the home 3 keep the Sabbath. While 52% of the participants have children, only 1 out

of 2 children is inside the church. 56.6% are married and living with their spouse, 32.4% are single, 5% divorced, 2.3% are separated, 2.7% are widowed, while 1% of the participants declared living in a free union.




Figure 4. Household Data




Figure 5. Years of Baptize

In fig 5 we can see for how long the participants have baptized. 20.9& indicated they have been baptized for a period between 2 and 5 years, while a lower percentage indicated between 31 and 50 years.




Figure 6. Church attendance

30% indicated they have been Adventists from birth and 39% are first generation Adventists. 68% are involved in the activities of the church and develop a position. 73% of participants perceive that their church has a membership of less than or equal to 200 members, while 27% reported a membership greater than 200 members. In 80% reported and attendance to the cults on Saturday less than or equal to 200 members, while 20% reported an attendance greater than 200 members.

Section 3. Religious behavior

Regarding the activities programmed by the church, a descriptive analysis with crossed tables was used, where the percentage of attendance at the church in the services during the week was obtained with scales of (100% more than once a week and 0% never).




Figure 7. Attendance at the service in days per week

It is observed that 86.9% of the population attends church services more than once a week and only 3.1% indicated that they do not attend any service.

Professional leadership is very important within, 39% have been visited once or of the population said they are never visited by their pastor, 30% visit them once or twice a year, 14% said that at least once a quarter, 7% once a month and only 5% said that their pastor visits them one or more times per week.





Figura 8. The frequency with which the pastor visits me

Regarding activities that are carried out alone or as a family, daily or more than once a week, 50% said that they read their Bible daily, 40.1% a few times a week, 7.6% once a month and 2.3% said they never studied their Bible.

48.5% of the participants said that they perform their personal devotion daily and 46.8% their Sabbath school lesson.

It is also observed that 15% of the population reads the religious writings of Adventist authors daily and only 4% of the population reads other religious authors daily.

50.6% of the participants of the Inter-American Division have stated that they have not used social networks to transmit the message, while only 7.8% indicated that they use them daily.

On the other hand, the church has implemented enrichment programs for its members such as revival and reformation, the method of Christ to reach people and the pro-health message, the Inter-American Division had a higher percentage of participation in the program, revival and reformation with 43.6% having participated and a lower percentage of participation in the pro-health message with only 32.4% of its members participating.




Figure 10. Programs developed by the Adventist Church

Section 4. Religious attitudes and experiences

It is fundamental for members to know about the issues that concern their spiritual life development, so the frequency with which they receive these topics is presented (100% frequently, 0% I do not know).

It can be seen that in the Inter-American Division the subject of the Sabbath is preached more frequently, followed by the harmonious way of life and with the least frequency we find the spirit of prophecy and the state of the dead are found.




Figure 11. The frequency with which my pastor preaches the following topics

Of the population, 40.7% are committed to Christ because of a change that suddenly or gradually arose, 29% have remained committed since their childhood, 16.5% said they were committed but it did not last, and 1.4% is not or does not feel committed to Christ.




Figure 12. Commitment to Jesus Christ

The experience within the church in the last year, 60.7% of the participants indicated that they would use their spiritual gifts for the service of the church, 50% mention that they feel loved by the members of their church, 41.1% of the population find a certain closeness and unity among and 62.7% indicate that they do not feel pressured to behave in a certain way.

71% of participants in the Inter-American Division said they were satisfied, while 94% of the population indicated that they found a lifelong commitment to the Adventist Church.

Concerning religious attitudes and experiences, the Anova statistical technique was used to make the comparisons between the variables (1. Identity and mission, 2. Training and leadership, 3. Biblical foundations).

It can be seen that in terms of identity and mission, the Union with the highest score has the Dominican Union and with less the Union of Belize.




Figure 13. Satisfaction and commitment with the IASD




Figure 14. Anova of satisfaction with the local church

In relation to the biblical foundations that the members of the church have, it is observed that the Unions with the greatest values are the Honduran Union, the Haitian Union, and the North Mexican Union; while the Unions with the lowest rates are the Union of Belize, the Puerto Rican Union, and the Interoceanic Mexican Union.




Figure 15. Biblical foundations by union

Section 5. Wellness

The aspects of religious life in the participants contribute to their sense of general and spiritual well-being. The scale of measurement in this question is as follows (1. Not at all happy, 2. Not very happy, 3. Quite happy, 4. Very happy). The table (2) indicates that 44.9% of the population feels happy in general and spiritually.

The importance of knowing in what situation of their life the participants are represented is numbered from 0 to 10 which indicates that the lower number is the worst possible life and the 10 the best possible life, 78.5% of participants said they have a better life while 3.2% said they do not have a better life, 18.4% said they have neither a great nor a bad life.

The spiritual growth of the participants in the last 12 months has been analyzed with the scale (1. It is not true for me, 2. I am not sure, 3. It is very true), the participants stated the following: 60% have grown spiritually with, 33% said they are not sure if they have grown spiritually and 7% said they had not had spiritual growth in the last year.

A very important issue in society is anger and bitterness that is why 60% of the participants have said that they try to avoid them, to have a better coexistence and harmony in their environment. While 12% have problems in their interpersonal relationships and 28% are not sure to avoid the anger and bitterness itself.

Section 6. Beliefs

We analyzed the content of question number 41, of section 6 "Beliefs", which is made up of 32 items, using Factorial Analysis, using the factor extraction method by Principal Component Analysis, with Varimax rotation with Kaiser normalization. The sample data corresponding to the Unions of the Inter-American Division was analyzed.

The reliability of the instrument was validated using the internal consistency method based on the Cronbach's Alpha coefficient. With n = 32 elements analyzed, a Cronbach's Alpha coefficient of 0.805 was reported, which suggests that the instrument is reliable, considering that, as a general rule, reliability should not be less than 0.8 [1].

The instrument uses the Likert measurement scale of 5 points: 1: Strongly disagree, 2: Disagree, 3: I'm not sure, 4: Agree, 5: Strongly agree.

Three factors were extracted that together explain 40.344% of the total variability. The sedimentation graph suggests that the individual contributions to the total variability of more factors are not significant. The Kaiser-Meyer-Olkin measure of sampling adequacy was 0.952, which suggests that the factor analysis is adequate for the sample analyzed. Bartlett's sphericity test (value p = 0.000) also suggests the adequacy of the data to be analyzed by means of factor analysis.

The variables generated by means of the identified factors were:

- 1. *Fundamental Beliefs;* Question 41, Items 1,2, 4, 6,8,9,11,12,13,14,15,17,19,22,25,30, 31,32.
- 2. It is a confusing factor.
- 3. Spiritual Implications Question 41, Items 3,7,10,18,20,23.

Anova of a factor

Average performance between Unions was compared by means of the average score (score) obtained, with respect to each of the three factors extracted, by means of Analysis of Variance of a factor (Anova) with paired comparisons of Tukey.




Figure 16. Religious implications by age

For the variable "Religious Implications" we found evidence of a significant effect of the "Age Group" factor with respect to the average score obtained (value p = 0.00). Tukey's comparisons suggest three homogeneous subsets of age with respect to the variable "Age Group" the first subset are the age groups (31-45, 46-60, more than 60), the second subset is the ages (More of 60, 46-60, 16-30) both subsets show that they do not have a confused perception of in the spiritual realm, the state of the dead and

salvation while the third subset of age <= 15 have no security with respect to the subjects mentioned above figure (15). Similarly, for the variable "Fundamental Beliefs" 3 subsets were obtained which indicate that the participants have an attachment to the beliefs of the church figure (16)




Figure 17. Fundamental beliefs by age

In the same way, the effect of the factor "Union" and "Gender of the participant" was analyzed on the average score obtained, for each of the two factors (variables) extracted (Spiritual Implications and Fundamental Beliefs).

No evidence of a significant effect of the factor "Gender of the participant" (p value> 0.05) was found on the average score obtained for the variable (Fundamental beliefs).

A significant effect of the "Union" factor was found on the average score obtained with respect to the variables "Spiritual Implications" (value p = 0.019) and "Fundamental beliefs" (value p = 0.00).

For the variable "Fundamental Beliefs" the Puerto Rican and Venezuelan unions have a higher score than the other unions, the figure (17) indicates that all the unions have an attachment to their beliefs with a score > 4 that means they agree with this factor, according to the Likert measurement scale mentioned above.




Figure 18. Fundamental beliefs by Union

Regarding the variable "Spiritual Implications" the unions show a score < 3 which, according to the Likert scale, there is no confused persecution in the factor (figure 18).




Figure 19. Religious implications by Union

The participants surveyed believe in the writings of Prophetess Ellen White (94%) and that she was a person inspired by God who dictated her word by word without being influenced by her environment, however, there is a percentage of 2.4 that does not even know of this prophetess, 1.3% said that her writings contain no more truth than other religious works and 2.3% said that she created stories of supernatural guidance to explain the mysteries of life. On the other hand, 93.1% indicated that they accept from the heart the unity of three equal and eternal Persons (the Trinity), 4.4% accept it because the church demands it, 1.6% have doubts about the subject and 0.9% do not accept it.

Section 7. Health

The church is an organization that similarly promotes health, which is why the type of diet of the unions surveyed is described.




Figure 20. Type of diet

The unions report that most of their members eat meat a few times a week, which indicates that there is a percentage of 42.6 that follows the pro-health message moderately and a 26.1 constantly applies it in their life.

In the last year, 7% of the participants have consumed alcohol and 2% of tobacco, which indicates that it is a minimal percentage, however, it is not suitable for health. Because of this 50% said that they can not choose which parts of the health message to follow and which ones to ignore, this indicates that they feel obliged to follow this message, while 13.7% are not sure about choosing to follow it and 36.3% feel the freedom to choose the health message.
