According to a recent study, 39.25% of all members over the last 50 years have left the Church (Office of Archives, Statistics, and Research, 2015). First Love: Dropouts' Beginning Experiences in the Seventh-day Adventist Church

Do you remember when you fell in love for the first time? Now, do you remember when you first became a Seventh-day Adventist or how you felt after being baptized? For many people, coming to know Jesus for the first time is similar to those "first love" feelings. According to the Center for Creative Ministry, strong church doctrine, friendships, and charisma of the preacher were the top three factors that drew in new converts. They also found that many converts were initially excited about the Church and were eager to commit their lives to Christ, with 39% spending less than a year between their first contact with the Church and their baptism. When did things change – turning these passionate converts into disillusioned dropouts?
