




2017-18 Global Church Member Survey Subsamples






Gender & Relationships with the Adventist Church











Devotional Practices

- 4% of youth have children living with them at home




Church Attendance, Location, & Climate




Perceived Church Attendance










Attendance during the Last 12 Months




How Often during the Last 12 Months? [Every week or more than once a week]












Do you Hold a Church Office at your Local Church?




Involvement in Church Ministry during the Last 12 Months (Every week or more than once a week)






My Church Has a Program for Preparing Young People to Become Leaders (strongly agree or agree)












Doctrines: State of the Dead







 Focus on young people, especially 16-21 age group (Ambassadors, high school and college students), in all aspects of their spiritual life and service


